***Dear suppliers of chemical substances
for OJSC "Naftan***

Please be informed that TR EAEU 041/2017 “On safety of chemical products” establishes uniform mandatory safety requirements for chemical products released for circulation on the territory of the Eurasian Economic Union.

In connection with the development of the national Register of Chemical Substances and Mixtures and the necessity to include in the above-mentioned Register chemicals produced by you, we ask you to take part in the ***inventory of chemical substances and mixtures***, which is organized and implemented in the Republic of Belarus on the basis of **the Republican Unitary Enterprise "Scientific and Practical Center of Hygiene":**

or take part *in the inventory in the country of residence.*

If you are a resident of the Republic of Belarus, you need to download the template for the inventory at <http://certificate.by> (in the section Tests, Chemical and Petrochemical Industry), fill in the information about your chemicals and send the completed template to RUE "Scientific and Practical Center of Hygiene" by e-mail inventar@rspch.by.

If you are not a resident of the Republic of Belarus, but are located on the territory of one of the EAEU Member States, it is possible to perform the inventory in any state of the Union.

If you are located outside the EAEU, you should also take part in the inventory of chemicals and mixtures. For this purpose it is necessary to apply in writing to naftan@naftan.by to address the issue of participation of your substances in the inventory.

At the stage of inventory of chemicals and mixtures, the Regulator requests a piece of minimum information on chemical substances.

Inventory procedure is free of charge, and does not require provision of any documents confirming the fact of a substance circulation in the EAEU territory, and for filling out the template you can use data from safety data sheets (SDS).

In case the supplier of chemical and/or petrochemical products does not pass the procedure of chemicals inventory, and data on products are not included in the Register, such products will be considered “new” for the territory of the EAEU, and before releasing to the market they will have to undergo an expensive and long-term notification procedure, which is a comprehensive study of the substances as new ones to determine their toxicological and ecotoxicological properties affecting human health and the environment, with subsequent drawing up a chemical safety report and registration procedure of such substances in the Register.

This procedure is comparable to the notification and registration of substances under REACH.

If after the completion of the procedure of inventory of chemical substances and mixtures (the date of 01.08.2020 is tentatively determined by the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Belarus) your chemical products are not included in the Register, the delivery of your products to the EAEU territory will be suspended until the mandatory procedures of notification, subsequent registration and entry in the Register are completed.

Please be informed that only manufacturers of chemicals, whose substances are entered in the Register or pass the notification procedure and are registered, will be admitted to procurement procedures at OJSC “Naftan”.
